#### DAY 5 | CRUISING THE DANUBE RIVER, LINZ

There's more to Linz than its famous Linzer torte, although that alone makes it well worth a visit. The city has a thriving contemporary art scene, and its two Christmas Markets are over-the-top enchanting. In keeping with the Austrian traditions of good food and good music, Linz gave rise to both the Linzer torte and the Linz Symphony. The symphony is one of Mozart's most celebrated works. The story goes that the composer was so inspired by the beauty of the city that he finished his Symphony No. 36 in less than a week here in 1783.

# DAY 6 | CRUISING THE WACHAU VALLEY, DÜRNSTEIN, VIENNA

After a scenic cruise through the beautiful Wachau Valley, we'll reach the tiny village of Dürnstein. Walk along its cobbled streets, browse the shops selling apricot schnapps, and perhaps take a quick jaunt up to the ruins of a castle



(with an intriguing tale all its own). Later, you can taste a local spin on mulled wine and attend an organ concert at an Augustine church.

#### Day 7 | VIENNA

Be sure to try the rum balls and nutmeg-spiced macarons, which are local favorites, and amble through the adjacent park to admire the elaborately decorated trees.

# DAY 8 | VIENNA (DISEMBARK)

Disembark the ship. If your cruise package includes a group departure transfer, or if you have purchased a private departure transfer, you will be transferred to Vienna International Airport for your flight home.



#### A VALID PASSPORT IS REQUIRED FOR THIS TRIP

Your passport cannot expire for at least <u>6 months</u> after your return. If you are not an American Citizen, you are responsible for having proper documentation to enter any of the ports of call. If you reside outside of the US or Canada, please check with your consulate to see if you need a visa. If you do not have proper paperwork, you may be denied boarding.

<u>PAYMENTS</u>: A 10% deposit of total price is due with booking. Final payment is due July 25, 2025. You may use a credit card for deposit (without fee). We accept AX, Visa, & MC.

CANCELLATIONS: 120 days or more before cruise start: \$250 per person for cruise-tour.

Within 119 - 90 days of cruise start: 25% of the fare\*.

Within 89 - 60 days of cruise start: 50% of the fare\*.

Within 59 - 30 days of cruise start: 75% of the fare\*.

Less than 30 days before cruise start: 100% of the fare\*.

\*Fare is defined as the cost of any cruise, or land, element purchased from Uniworld. NO-SHOWS are subject to 100% penalty, applicable to bookings for all sailing regions. If air is cancelled one hundred and nineteen (119) days prior to departure or less, the full price of your air is non-refundable. 
